WILLIE J. FRINK JR. AND LORETTA FRINK WERE CHERISHED COMMUNITY LEADERS, WILLIE WAS A U.S. MILITARY VETERAN, AND VISIONARY GENERAL CONTRACTOR WHOSE LIFE LEFT A LASTING IMPACT ON BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA AND THE CENTRAL VALLEY. WILLIE WAS BORN ON APRIL 1, 1930, IN CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA, HE LATER RELOCATED TO BAKERSFIELD, WHERE HE AND HIS WIFE LORETTA FOUNDED A CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN 1963. THROUGH DEDICATION, SKILL, AND INTEGRITY, THEY BECAME ONE OF THE REGION'S MOST RESPECTED BLACK BUSINESS OWNERS, KNOWN FOR THEIR HIGH-QUALITY WORK AND UNWAVERING COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE.

MR. & MRS. FRINK'S INFLUENCE EXTENDED FAR BEYOND CONSTRUCTION. GENEROUS AND COMPASSIONATE, THEY GAVE COUNTLESS YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN THEIR FIRST OPPORTUNITIES IN THE WORKFORCE, MENTORING THEM IN BOTH SKILL AND CHARACTER. THEIR LEADERSHIP AND EXAMPLE HELPED CULTIVATE A CULTURE OF OPPORTUNITY, RESILIENCE, AND PRIDE WITHIN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY.
