HENRY SHIPES WAS A RESPECTED AFRICAN AMERICAN BUSINESS OWNER AND CIVIC LEADER IN BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA, WHOSE WORK HELPED EXPAND OPPORTUNITIES FOR BLACK ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND ECONOMIC ADVANCEMENT. AS THE OWNER OF MR. DISCOUNT PLUS, HE STRENGTHENED THE LOCAL ECONOMY WHILE CREATING JOBS AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR AFRICAN AMERICANS AT A TIME WHEN RACIAL DISCRIMINATION MADE BUSINESS OWNERSHIP AND FINANCIAL GROWTH ESPECIALLY CHALLENGING. HIS SUCCESS REFLECTED DETERMINATION, RESILIENCE, AND A DEEP COMMITMENT TO SERVING HIS COMMUNITY.

BEYOND HIS BUSINESS ACHIEVEMENTS, SHIPES WAS KNOWN FOR HIS CIVIC ENGAGEMENT AND LEADERSHIP. HE ADVOCATED FOR GREATER REPRESENTATION, FAIRNESS, AND INCLUSION IN BAKERSFIELD'S PUBLIC AND ECONOMIC LIFE, HELPING TO LAY THE GROUNDWORK FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS OF BLACK BUSINESS OWNERS AND COMMUNITY LEADERS.
